

- 2 Head past the Youth Club on your left .

What type of tree do we decorate at Christmas?

- 4 Turn right along Bridge Road.
- **5** Cross Bridge Road, heading towards the Inn.

6 Pass the Green shop on your right.

What hours do the Green Shop open?

Carry on past the row of houses, minding out for cars.

8	Continue on to The Street	
9	Head through the Lychgate into the field beyond.	Look out for squirrels!
10	Turn left after the church, heading over the stile.	Name the husband of this church's Patron Saint.
11	When you reach the Trafalgar Oak, take the left fork.	On what date was the Battle Of Trafalgar?
12	Cross the road and head through the kissing gate.	
13	Cross over Meadow View and continue down the track.	
14	Follow the track to the left, be careful, it can be muddy!	
15	Head directly across this road and continue along the pathway.	What does FWSA stand for?
16	Carry Straight on.	What type of log do we eat at Christmas?
17	Head across the field and take the stile into the Sailing club.	
18	Cross the road here, head over the turnstile and walk North-East across the field.	
19	Take the right hand stile, following the yellow markers, keep to the left of this field.	
20	Exit the field, heading down the tree-lined pathway.	
21	Carry straight on.	What is Diwali also known as?
22	Cross over the car park.	
23	Just before the 5 bar gate out on to the main road, turn left onto the dirt track.	

24	Carry straight on.	How many reindeer does Santa have?
2 5	When you reach the second Frampton Court Estate board, turn left and head across the field.	
26	Turn right and follow the road out to the car park.	What does Hannukah translate to from Hebrew?
27	Turn right and head back along the green.	
28	Head across the green, crossing Bridge Road and back on to Whitminster Lane.	What is the name of the Indian Goddess of wealth, celebrated during Diwali?
29	Head straight on, past the bus stops.	The bus stop was provided for the Queen's Jubilee in which year?
