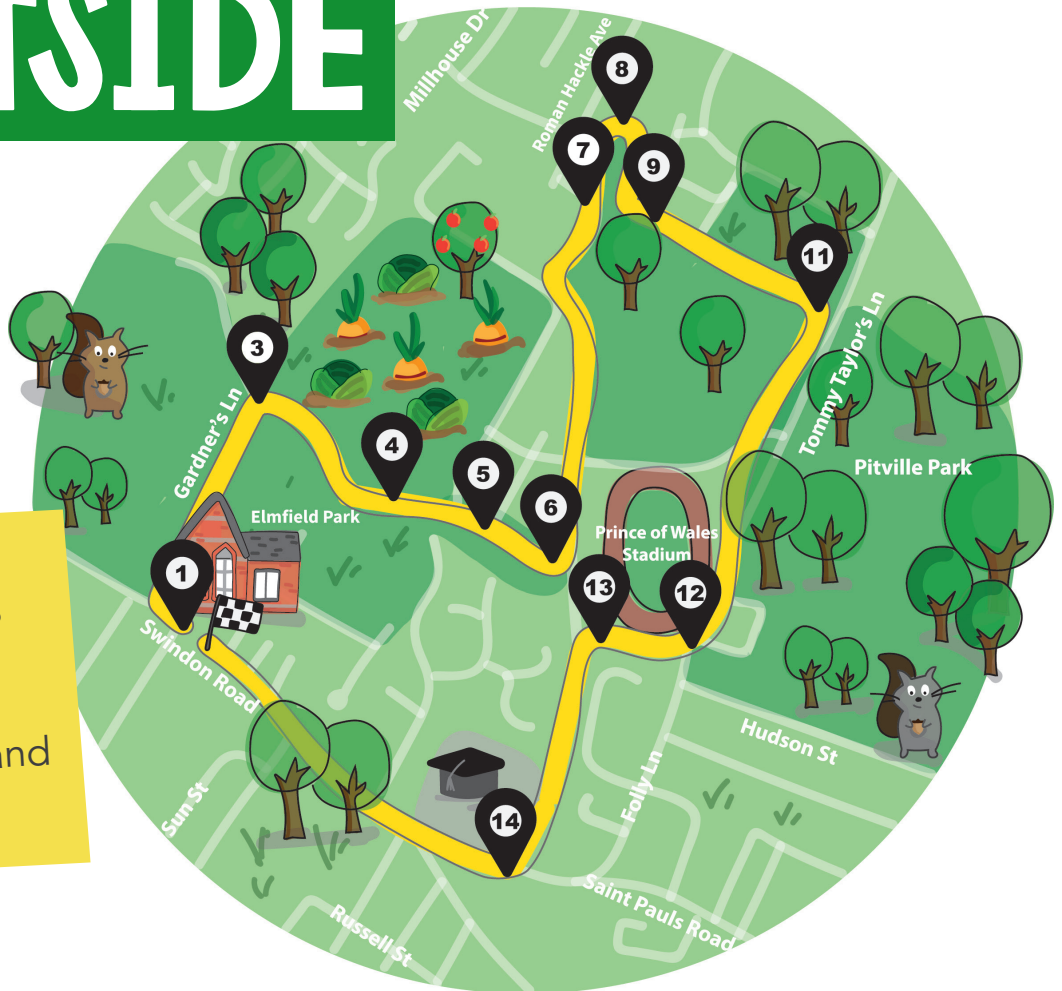




# GO OUTSIDE

## Welcome to the GO Outside Gardners Lane Trail!

Follow the directions and  
answer questions.



## Directions

- 1** Start at the Swindon Rd. Entrance to Gardners Lane Primary school. Turn right and walk down Gardners Lane.
- 2** Keep walking down Gardners Lane.
- 3** Keep walking down G.Lane and turn right onto the footpath through Elmfield park.
- 4** Keep going straight along the path across the park and onto a road with some houses on.
- 5** Turn right and walk towards the floodlights. Challenge: Can you cross the obstacle course without touching the floor?

## Puzzles and Facts

Puzzle 1: When was the commemorative stone in the school wall laid?

Puzzle 2: How many children are on the Gardners Lane Children's Centre sign?

Did you know? This park has been here since the 1800's and used to be part of a farm growing gooseberries and currants.

Puzzle 3: You can see some floodlights on your right- What is the name of the stadium they belong to?

Puzzle 4: On your right there is a grey fenced off area - What do you think this is?

Turn right here onto the Honeybourne footpath if you want a shorter walk (go to 13)



Turn left on the Honeybourne footpath and go across the road.

Puzzle 5: What do you think this footpath used to be?



Stay on this path, going behind the houses. Next go across the bridge and turn right.

Challenge: How fast can you cross the playground?



When you see a gate in the hedge turn right onto the old Honeybourne line. Turn right again and walk back down the footpath.



When you get to the end of the footpath there will be some trees on your left. Go through them and into a field.

Puzzle 6: What is the name of this park?



Go straight on, up the hill towards the main road.

Puzzle 7: What do you think this area used to be?

Hint: we need these to build houses.



When you get to the main road turn right and head towards the Prince of Wales Stadium.

Puzzle 8: How many floodlights can you see here?



Go past the stadium and turn right onto a cycle path then left back onto the Honeybourne way.

Did you know? There is a paint festival which takes place in September - take a picture of yourself with some graffiti and send it in to @gooutsideuk.



Take the first exit off the footpath on the right. When you get to the main road you will see some buildings on the other side of the bridge on the opposite side of the road.

Puzzle 9: What do you think these buildings used to be?

A) Workhouse. B) Church. C) School.



Now turn right, back down St. Paul's road towards the school.

Puzzle 10: You will see another mural from the Paint festival on a building ahead- how many colours are included in it?

Well done! You have completed the Go Outside Gardners Lane trail. Keep walking and you will be back at the school.
