## Directions

## Puzzles and Facts

**1** Start with the school behind you, turn left and walk down Stratton road

Can you spot anything interesting on no.s 24,26 and 28? What do you think it is?

**2** Continue down the road

In the early 1840's there was a large house and grounds on the road called Barton Lawn- it used to sit next to where the school is today.

**3** At the end of the road turn left and cross over

Can you spot the mosaic on the wall here? What animal is at the top?

**4** Walk past the allotment and farm on the right

What plants can you spot? You can visit the allotment on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday and find out more about what they grow and even have a go yourself!

**5** Turn right towards St James' City farm

How many different animals can you see?

**6** Come back towards the main road and turn right, along the side of the farm

Up until the 1890's the area where the farm now sits was a large sand pit.

**7** Turn right when you get to the church and head into St James' Park

There is lots of wildlife here- how many different types of tree can you spot on your walk through the park?

**8** Follow the path through the park

What flying objects can you see on the mural?

- 9** Continue on the path past a playground Challenge: How quickly can you cross the balance beam and stepping stones?
- 10** Leave the park and turn right, walking straight towards the main road
- 11** Turn right at the main road What can you see on the side of the wall at Dynevor Street?
- 12** Keep walking up the road Number 33 has a funny name- can you spot what it is?
- 13** Turn right onto a footpath between the buildings Here are some raised beds for growing plants- do you know what is being grown here? Take a photo to ask at the allotment if you're not sure.
- 14** Continue on the path, turning left What animal is in the paddock here?
- 15** Visit the allotment if it is open (Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays) Can you find the pond- what wildlife is living here?
- 16** Head out of the allotment and back onto the main road Can you see a building with a pointed roof? What is it?
- 17** Turn left, then right onto Saint James' Street
- 18** Walk past St. James' School on the right How many figures can you count inside the shield on their emblem?
- 19** Turn left at the end of the road You will see a police station on the right. Can you spot the old lantern near the door?
- 20** Continue walking past the bus stop to the traffic lights The building on the left here has lots of fancy stonework- what patterns can you spot?
- 21** Turn left down Hopewell Street You will pass a building on the right with a green front. How many faces can you spot? Can you work out what this used to be?
- 22** Continue walking down the street What is laid into the wall next to number 32? What do you think this is?
- 23** Turn right at the end of the road, then right again back towards the school Well Done! You have completed the Al-ashraf Primary School trail!
